

VILLAGE OF RIDGEWOOD
ORDINANCE NO. 3320

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 265 OF THE CODE
OF THE VILLAGE OF RIDGEWOOD, VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC,
AT
SECTION 265-36, "PARKING PROHIBITED CERTAIN HOURS"

BE IT ORDAINED by the Village Council of the Village of Ridgewood:

Section 1. Chapter 265, Vehicles and Traffic of the Code of the Village of Ridgewood is hereby amended as follows:

ADD

Chapter 265, Section 265-36, "Parking Prohibited Certain Hours"

- B. Permit Required Overnight Parking shall be permitted only between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. in the Prospect Street Parking Lot bounded by Van Neste Square, Dayton Street, and Prospect Street; in the Hudson Street Parking Lot bounded by Hudson Street and South Broad Street; in the Wilsey Square parking site bounded by the New Jersey Transit Railroad and Wilsey Square, and in the Cottage Place Parking Lot bounded by Cottage Place and East Ridgewood Avenue, and in those locations to be designated from time to time by the Director of Public Works or his/her authorized representative.
- (1) Users will be limited to residents of the Village of Ridgewood who purchase permits for this privilege on a quarterly basis, as set forth in Chapter 145, Fees, from the Director of Finance.
 - (2) This privilege is limited to passenger cars, and the Village of Ridgewood disclaims any responsibility for damage to vehicles or contents, including theft or vandalism.
 - (3) All cars must be removed at the expiration of the permitted parking period and when the site is posted "No Parking" for snow removal purposes. Owners of vehicles towed shall pay all costs for removal and storage.

DELETE

Chapter 265, Section 265-36, "Parking Prohibited Certain Hours"

- B. Permit Required Overnight Parking shall be permitted only between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. in the Prospect Street Parking Lot bounded by Van Neste Square, Dayton Street, and Prospect Street; in the

Hudson Street Parking Lot bounded by Hudson Street and South Broad Street; in the Wilsey Square parking site bounded by the New Jersey Transit Railroad and Wilsey Square, and in the Cottage Place Parking Lot bounded by Cottage Place and East Ridgewood Avenue, and in those locations to be designated from time to time by the Director of Public Works.

- (1) Users will be limited to residents of the Village of Ridgewood who purchase permits for this privilege on a quarterly basis, as set forth in Chapter 145, Fees, from the Director of Finance.
- (2) This privilege is limited to passenger cars, and the Village of Ridgewood disclaims any responsibility for damage to vehicles or contents, including theft or vandalism.
- (3) All cars must be removed at the expiration of the permitted parking period and when the site is posted "No Parking" for snow removal purposes. Owners of vehicles towed shall pay all costs for removal and storage.

Section 2: Except as herein amended and supplemented, Chapter 265, of The Code of the Village of Ridgewood remains in full force and effect.

Section 3: This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication as required by law.
