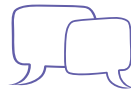
Volunteering with The Trevor Project

Volunteers are trained to support LGBTQ youth who reach out about issues such as coming out, LGBTQ identity, depression, and suicide. You can apply for volunteer opportunities from anywhere in the U.S. Join us and help save young LGBTQ lives. Please note that volunteers must be at least 18 years old to apply.



Call – Crisis Counselors are trained to answer calls on our 24/7 Lifeline from young people who are feeling suicidal or need a safe, non-judgmental place to talk.



Chat & Text – Digital Crisis Counselors are trained to answer chats or texts from LGBTQ young people who reach out on our free, confidential and secure 24/7 service when they are struggling with issues such as coming out, LGBTQ identity, depression, and suicide.

Ending LGBTQ youth suicide

Suicide is the **second leading cause of death** among young people

Lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender youth are more than **4x more likely to attempt suicide** than their peers

Up to 50% of all trans people have made a suicide attempt – many before the age of 25

We estimate that each year **1.8 million+ LGBTQ youth** in the U.S. seriously consider suicide each year and could benefit from our services.

Accepting adults **decrease the risk of LGBTQ youth attempting suicide by 40%**

The Trevor Project aims to always be there for LGBTQ youth in crisis with a clear message: they should be proud of who they are and that they are not alone.
